§3.b Using "boost" to increase outreach

Föredragande/Speaker: Fortuna Cirillo

Bakgrund / Background: We've been spending money to boost Instagram posts, hoping for more visibility and likes. Recently, the board also agreed to fund associations so they could do the same. In practice, though, results are weak: most boosted posts get 5–10 likes, with a few reaching around 80. Despite having about 3,000 followers, boosts haven't translated into consistent engagement or meaningful outreach.

Why boosting isn't working:

1. Followers ≠ engagement

Studies show follower numbers are a poor predictor of per-post likes or interaction. Simply having 3,000 followers doesn't guarantee strong engagement. (ScienceDirect)

2. Organic reach is shrinking

Platforms increasingly operate on a "pay-to-play" model, limiting organic visibility.

Boosting may expand reach, but rarely creates long-term, relevant engagement. (Hootsuite)

3. Boosts are a blunt tool

They target broad audiences without offering detailed segmentation, creative testing, or messaging flexibility. This means more impressions, but not necessarily stronger connections. (Bastion Agency)

4. Content quality matters most

Research confirms that relevance, interactivity, and emotional resonance are the real drivers of engagement. Paid spend can amplify strong content but it cannot fix weak or mis-targeted content. (PMC)

What this means for us

Boosting currently offers low returns: we spend money, gain a few extra impressions and likes, but little meaningful involvement. With funds now allocated to both the union and associations/sections, it's time to rethink.

Recommended alternatives

- Regular, relevant posts (events, student stories, polls) encourage consistent engagement.
- Prioritize community-building: interactive content (Q&As, polls, challenges) and reposting student content fosters stronger connections.
- Explore offline and hybrid outreach: on-campus activations, flyers with QR codes, and co-sponsored events can convert better than paid impressions.
 - Add a Stories highlight for events so info stays accessible.
 - Run more interactive polls and stories to involve students in decisions
 - Share a monthly "What's Coming Up" post to build anticipation.
 - Pin posts introducing the union and all associations for clarity and visibility.

Boosting posts is an easy fix but our experience, and research, show it doesn't deliver lasting engagement both for us and for associations. By focusing on stronger content, community partnerships, smarter campaigns, and better metrics, we can use our resources far more effectively to connect with students. We have better ways to spend that money!

§4.a Ensuring Constitutional Compliance in Agenda Preparation and Motion Handling/
Säkerställa konstitutionell efterlevnad i dagordning förberedelse och hantering av motion

Föredragande / speaker: Fortuna Cirillo

Bakgrund: Enligt §14 i Konstitutionen har kårens medlemmar rätt att lämna in motioner till fullmäktige minst fjorton (14) dagar före ett fullmäktigemöte. Detta innebär att styrelsen ska ge sitt yttrande och inte skjuta upp diskussionen till efter FUM. Att fördröja diskussionen på detta sätt riskerar att bryta mot Konstitutionen genom att hindra fullmäktige från att behandla motioner som skickats in i tid.

På senare tid har det hållits färre styrelsemöten, vilket ofta innebär att inget möte hålls minst åtta (8) dagar före FUM. Detta begränsar styrelsens möjlighet att förbereda svar och minskar tiden för meningsfulla interna diskussioner inför fullmäktigemöten.

För att åtgärda detta föreslås att Kårstyrelsen säkerställer att ett möte planeras in mellan fjorton (14) och åtta (8) dagar före varje FUM. Detta skulle säkerställa konstitutionell efterlevnad och ge möjlighet att på rätt sätt behandla alla motioner som skickats in i tid.

Background: According to §14 of the Constitution, Union members have the right to submit motions to the Council at least fourteen (14) days prior to a Council meeting. This means the Board should provide its opinion and not postpone discussion until after FUM. Delaying discussion in this way risks violating the Constitution by preventing the Council from considering motions submitted on time.

Recently, there have been fewer Board meetings, which often results in no meeting being held at least eight (8) days before FUM. This limits the Board's ability to prepare responses and reduces the time available for meaningful internal discussions before Council meetings.

To address this, it is suggested that the Union Board ensures a meeting is scheduled between fourteen (14) and eight (8) days before each FUM. This would ensure compliance with the Constitution and allow all motions submitted on time to be properly reviewed and discussed.

§4.d Adjustment of the Required Number of Board Meetings

Föredragande / speaker: Aaron Monaci

Background: Following the board's reconstruction two years ago, the responsibilities of its members have significantly increased. The reorganization assigned specific faculty responsibilities to certain board members, making them representatives for their entire faculty. These members are required to participate in Fakultetsstyrelsen, Lärarförbundsnaämnden and Utbildningsnaämnden, which are among the most time-intensive university bodies. Each of these requires thorough preparation and review of extensive documentation prior to the meetings, and they occur on a frequent basis, leaving very few weeks free from meeting obligations.

In addition to these duties, the same board members are also FUM representatives and, like all their colleagues, must prepare and participate in FUM sessions. They are further required to be active in at least one of the four union committees. Beyond these formal roles, these members are full-time students who regularly contribute to the union's daily operations, student representation, and events aimed at increasing student engagement. Their faculty responsibilities often involve extra meetings beyond those initially planned, and they are frequently asked by faculty or other "aktörer" to step in, as it is needed to support union work.

This accumulation of responsibilities has led to a significant workload for the faculty-responsible board members. The current bylaw requirement for a fixed number of board

meetings per term, based on the previous structure of the Union, no longer reflects the realities of the restructured

board. Maintaining the same frequency of meetings risks overburdening members, reducing efficiency, and affecting representation quality.

It is therefore proposed that the meeting decide to amend the bylaws to reduce the required number of board meetings, while still allowing the board to call additional meetings as needed.

Bakgrund: Efter den omorganisation som genomfördes för två år sedan har styrelsens arbetsbörda och ansvar ökat avsevärt. Omstruktureringen innebär att vissa styrelseledamöter fick särskilda fakultetsansvar, vilket innebär att de representerar hela sin fakultet. Dessa ledamöter är skyldiga att delta i Fakultetsstyrelsen, Lärarförbundsämnden och Utbildningsämnden, några av universitetets mest tidskrävande organ. Varje möte kräver omfattande förberedelser och genomgång av mycket dokumentation, och dessa möten sker ofta, vilket gör att ledamöterna sällan har någon helt mötesfri vecka.

Utöver detta är samma ledamöter även representanter i FUM och, precis som sina kollegor, måste de förbereda sig inför och delta i FUM-möten. De är dessutom aktiva i minst en av kårens fyra kommitté. Utöver dessa uppdrag är de heltidsstudenter som engagerar sig i kårens dagliga verksamhet, studentrepresentation och aktiviteter för att öka studenternas engagemang. Deras fakultetsansvar leder ofta till extra möten utöver de planerade, och de blir ofta ombedda att ställa upp vid av fakultet eller andra aktörer, som behövs för att stötta kårens arbete.

Denna samlade arbetsbelastning har blivit mycket hög för ledamöter med fakultetsansvar.

Den nuvarande stadgeregeln om ett fast antal styrelsemöten per termin speglar inte längre styrelsens nuvarande struktur och arbetssätt. Att behålla samma mötesfrekvens riskerar att överbelasta ledamöterna, minska effektiviteten och påverka kvaliteten på representationen.

Det föreslås därför att mötet beslutar att ändra stadgarna för att minska antalet obligatoriska styrelsemöten, samt att ge styrelsen möjlighet att kalla till extra möten vid behov

Motioner och styrelsen svar / Motions and the boards answer

§3.a Humanitarian crises in Palestine

Motinär: Fortuna Cirillo

Background: According to Chapter 1, §2 of the Student Union Malmö's Constitution, the purpose of the Union is to support students in their studies and study-related issues. The Union's activities are further guided by its core values: knowledge, **solidarity**, and inclusion.

In Palestine, and particularly in Gaza, students and academics are facing extreme humanitarian conditions, with universities and schools destroyed, and the right to education under direct threat. As a progressive student union, Malmö Student Union has both a moral and constitutional responsibility to take a position in line with its values.

There is precedent for this; the Student Union of Gothenburg has already taken a stand on May 9, 2025, urging their university to review collaborations with institutions complicit in violations of international law. link: <https://www.gotastudentkar.se/sv/nyheter/humanitar-kris-i-palestina> Malmö Student Union should do the same.

Please note that this proposal seeks that the Malmö Student Union implement the SAME stances as those announced by Gothenburg Student Union already in May 2025.

Proposal:

The Student Union Council resolves to:

Acknowledge the humanitarian crisis in Palestine and express solidarity with Palestinian students and academics with a publication on their website, as the Gothenburg Student Union has done.

With the following demands:

- That the Malmö Student Union takes a position on the University of Malmö ending collaborations with Israeli institutions that support or contribute to violations of international law and human rights.
- That the Malmö Student Union urges the University of Malmö to publicly condemn the ongoing war crimes and genocide in Palestine.
- That the Malmö Student Union demands that the University of Malmö introduce special support measures for Palestinian researchers and students, with a focus on safety and opportunities to continue their education and research.
- That the Malmö Student Union demands that the University of Malmö introduce support measures for all students and researchers at the university in cases where conflicts in the surrounding world negatively affect the well-being of students and researchers and their opportunities for continued education and work.
- That Malmö Student Union works to ensure that students have greater influence in decisions about the university's international collaborations.

Fortuna Cirillo föreslår att fullmäktige: erkänner den humanitära krisen i Palestina och uttrycker solidaritet med palestinska studenter och akademiker genom en publicering på deras webbplats, liksom Göteborgs studentkår har gjort.

Fortuna Cirillo suggests that the council: acknowledge the humanitarian crisis in Palestine and express solidarity with Palestinian students and academics with a publication on their website, as the Gothenburg Student Union has do

Styrelsen svar på motionen/ The boards answer on the motion

While we all personally sympathize with the humanitarian crisis in Palestine we as an organisation feel that our constitution and our clear assignment to represent all the students of Malmö university (ca 27 000), and not just specific groups or some of our members, constrains us to make a political statement regarding this matter. We fear that taking a stand and making a statement on this matter will definitely exclude some groups or better said some of them will feel excluded by that statement. According to our values we are standing for solidarity, equality and inclusion of all students at MAU.

Regarding the part of the motion that requires us to demand that the university take measures and take their stands regarding this conflict we need to respect their statement and regulations they follow for example Magna Charta that university has agreed upon together with other universities. However, even though we see that making a statement can be a problem we don't see an issue with us organising different activities connected to this humanitarian crisis but even the other ones. For example to organise donations, gather money, share stuff about organised activities in the city or other that can actually help people in need. We find it that making a statement is just a superficial way to show to others our stand but not really contributing to the crisis itself as we find the deeds are stronger than words itself.

In conclusion, we urge the council to explore other initiatives and ideas through which one can contribute meaningfully with real impact to addressing the ongoing crisis around the world. As a statement it is a NO go area. The Union remains committed to ensuring that everyone feels safe and heard, while continuing to promote positive impacts on education and our wider society.

§3.c Operation of the new Studentpub Structure / Strukturen på hur den nya Studentpuben kan vara

Motionär: Joel Löfqvist

Background: The Festmesteriet currently dominates student life — for example, by organizing the freshman events and running the Student Pub — which makes some students feel excluded. It's often the same group of people who arrange and take part in activities, creating a "closed circle" that's hard for others to enter. New members are usually friends of the Festmesteriet board, which reinforces the same group dynamic and makes it difficult for new ideas to emerge. We no longer have an active student pub, but a new one is planned to open in the future. The previous pub was managed by the Festmesteriet, and many students and associations found it difficult to collaborate with them when it came to using the pub. Several associations also felt underrepresented and struggled to organize their own events there.

The proposal is that the new student pub should be managed by a new board/organization, consisting of representatives from different student associations. This structure could ensure broader representation, create a more inclusive student environment, and provide a platform for new ideas and concepts. A key challenge in Malmö's student life today is the lack of venues for associations to host and develop their events—something the new pub could help solve.

Bakgrund: Festmesteriet "dominerar" idag studentlivet, med t.ex insparken och tog hand om Studentpuben vilket gör att vissa studenter känner sig utanför. Det är ofta samma grupp människor som arrangerar och deltar i evenemang, vilket skapar en "sluten cirkel" som är svår

för andra att komma in i. Nya människor som tillkommer är ofta kompisar till Festmesterietstyrelsen, vilket förstärker samma gruppdynamik och gör det svårt för nya idéer att växa fram.

Vi har för närvarande ingen aktiv studentpub, men en ny pub planeras att öppnas i framtiden. Den tidigare puben drevs av festmesteriet, och många studenter och föreningar upplevde svårigheter att samarbeta med dem när det gällde att använda puben. Flera föreningar kände också att de var underrepresenterade och hade svårt att arrangera egna evenemang där. Förslaget är att den nya studentpuben ska drivas av en ny styrelse/organisation med representanter från olika studentföreningar. En sådan struktur kan bidra till bättre representation, ett mer inkluderande studentliv och skapa en plattform för nya idéer och koncept. Ett stort problem i Malmös studentliv idag är att det saknas platser för föreningar att hålla och utveckla evenemang – något som den nya puben skulle kunna lösa.

Styrelsen svar / The boards answer

We think that this suggestion can be discussed and considered when we actually have a venue to share. Regarding the Insparken, the email will be sent to all associations as information that anyone can participate in Insparken activities as it is the activity that is organised by the Student Union Malmö and any association can participate. Festmesteriet is the association who is helping us out organising it and we are very thankful for that so whoever else wants to help us out is very welcome. The conversation regarding the accessibility of other people in the association fest should be taken separately with Fest.

§3.d Rönnen Venue Association / Rönnen Lokal Association

Motionär: Joel Löfquist

Background: I have worked at MKB Student as a building host. The student housing area **Rönnen** has a common space of about **270 m²**, with a maximum capacity of **150 people** and a rent of **20,000–25,000 SEK**. My Boss, who is responsible for all MKB Student housing in Malmö, would like this space to be used for student purposes.

I propose the creation of a **new student association** that would be responsible for managing this venue. The association's task would be to organize various events in collaboration with different student groups, specifically using this venue as a hub. Around **1,000 students** live in and around the Rönnen and other nearby student buildings, which makes the space a valuable resource.

If the student union (kåren) were to take responsibility for the venue through such an association, **Malmö municipality** would also need to be part of the discussion and agreement process.

Bakgrund: Jag har arbetat på MKB Student som husvärd. Studentbostadsområdet **Rönnen** har en lokal på cirka **270 m²**, med en maxkapacitet på **150 personer** och en hyra på **20 000–25 000 SEK**. Min chef, som är ansvarig för alla MKB Students byggnader i Malmö, vill att lokalen ska användas till studentverksamhet.

Jag föreslår därför att en **ny studentförening** skapas som får ansvaret för att förvalta lokalen. Föreningens uppgift skulle vara att organisera olika evenemang i samarbete med olika studentföreningar, med lokalen som en central plats. I och runt Rönnen samt de andra studenthusen i området bor det cirka **1 000 studenter**, vilket gör lokalen till en viktig resurs. Om kåren skulle vilja ta ansvar för lokalen genom en sådan förening, skulle även **Malmö stad** behöva involveras i diskussionen och beslutsprocessen.

Styrelsen svar / The boards answer

More information is needed from MKB in order to take this into consideration. We are not closed for collaboration. We need more clear information and a proposal from their side is needed in order to take this matter further.

§3.e Representing Students on the question on Housing / Representera Studenter på frågan om boende

Motionär: Joel Löfquist

Background: I have had discussions with MKB Student, and the head of MKB Student expressed an interest in having a **student tenant association**—run by students for students—that would represent student voices in matters related to housing. This could include topics such as rent levels and other aspects of housing representation.

I believe there is potential for the student union to take on this role, building on its existing structure and legitimacy. Therefore, I propose the creation of a **working group** to explore this idea further, including what form such representation could take and how it could be organized.

Bakgrund: Jag har haft diskussioner med MKB Student, och chefen för MKB Student har uttryckt intresse för att en **student hyresgästförening** – av studenter för studenter – skulle representera studenternas röst i frågor som rör boende. Detta skulle kunna handla om exempelvis hyresnivåer och andra aspekter av bostadsrepresentation.

Jag ser en möjlighet för kåren att ta på sig denna roll, utifrån dess redan existerande struktur och legitimitet. Därför föreslår jag att en **arbetsgrupp** skapas för att utforska denna idé närmare, inklusive vilken form representationen skulle kunna ta och hur den kan organiseras.

Styrelsen svar / The boards answer

The board suggests to use already existing forums instead of creating another similar association that is already existent and handles the matter of all tenants. However, we don't see an issue in creating a working group or better yet a committee in charge for this and other similar issues that will collaborate further on this matter with all existing forums/groups. We are already collaborating with the Jag vill ha bostad association as well as Studentstaden Malmö on all the matters regarding student accommodation. If we have a group or committee that can focus on this it could be more beneficial for the matter.

§3.f Motion on the transparency and accessibility of the Union budget

Motionärer: Simon Stenflo & Vega Wallin Färje

Background: As said in the constitution, Chapter 9, §9 quote: *“To the extent possible, all documents the Union holds shall be made available to all Union members and to the public. Since not all members can be assumed to speak Swedish, all documents shall be translated into English upon request in a timely manner.*

Documents likely to be of interest to all Union members shall be translated into English without need for any request. Some documents may be of a sensitive nature, such as working materials from the University or student errands, and the Union can deny access to these documents given that the Board provide explanation.” as well as in Chapter 2, §3.iv quote: *“A Union member has the right to: iv. have full access to the Union's documents.”*.

Students in the union have a right to know what their money is being spent on, and who's spending it. Therefore, we argue that the union's budget should be made public to everyone by posting it on the student union's website. Please note that this is not an absurd request. It aligns with our core constitutional values, and it aligns with the behaviour of other student unions. We have attached two other union budgets from two of Lunds student unions which we found on their websites to showcase this fact.

Therefore, as members of the student engagement committee we suggest that the union's

treasurer, or equivalent economically responsible member put together a budget report listing all union budgetary means and what they've been allocated for as well as what they were used for.

With an easily accessible public budget document, the council can also have an easier time reviewing and discussing the expenses and their validity.

To summarize, here's what our motion proposes

1. The union should seek to compile a publicly accessible budget document for the years 2025 & 2026. This document should list all incomes and expenses, with categories and subcategories so expenses can be tracked more closely.
2. This document should become an annual or biannual document that should be posted to our website for transparency and accountability.
3. If incomes are earmarked (i.e, reserved for certain activities) then this should be made clear

Styrelsen svar / The boards answer

We don't see a need for the first two proposals, since we go through the economy at FUM in order for them to follow what we spend the money on and how this correlates with the budget they decided upon, which is transparent for them. We also checked the example from the other Unions, sent by the motion's sender, and we saw that that union isn't organised the same way as ours, and therefore it doesn't make sense to us.

The student union members are also in FUM and on the board, and students voted for them in order to give them the mandate to address these and other questions. The only earmarked money the Union has is the rent that Malmö city pays, but we get it on an invoice to cover the exact cost.
